WHEREAS, the Forsyth County Department of Public Health receives Medicaid funds for the Pregnancy Care Management (PCM) Program; and Program oversight and monitoring of PCM is performed by the Northwest Community Care Network (NCCN); and

WHEREAS, the PCM Program has been approved by NCCN to spend project funds, including reserve funds, on special projects in order to improve birth outcomes; and

WHEREAS, the annual salary for a Nurse Care Manager is \$52,936; and the two temporary Nurse Care Manager positions will be funded by Medicaid funds and the positions will be eliminated once funding is exhausted; it is anticipated that project funding will last at least three (3) years;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the creation of two temporary Nurse Care Manager positions by the Forsyth County Department of Public Health to work at the local hospitals to coordinate follow-up with high-risk pregnant mothers for the PCM Program to improve birth outcomes in Forsyth County.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the salary for the Nurse Care Managers will be funded by Medicaid funds and the positions are expected to last at least three (3) years and will be eliminated when funding is exhausted.
