RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE NORTH CAROLINA HOUSING FINANCE AGENCY FOR 2016 ESSENTIAL SINGLE-FAMILY REHABILITATION LOAN POOL FUNDING (FORSYTH COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT)

BE IT RESOLVED that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes submission of an application to the North Carolina Housing Finance Agency for 2016 Essential Single-Family Rehabilitation Loan Pool (ESFRLP) funding for the period, July 2016 to July 2018, in an initial amount of \$175,000 to provide housing rehabilitation services for between five and ten substandard homes owned and/or occupied by elderly, disabled, Veteran fulltime household members, and/or a child six years old or younger with lead hazards, and receiving below 80% of the median income in Forsyth County, and located outside the Winston-Salem City limits.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman or the County Manager and the Clerk to the Board, or their designees, to execute, on behalf of Forsyth County, the necessary documents to submit the above-described funding application, subject to a pre-audit certificate thereon by the County Chief Financial Officer, if applicable, and approval as to form and legality by the County Attorney.
