**Meeting Called to Order**

A meeting of the Forsyth County Board of Elections was called to order in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Board Room on Tuesday, March 5, 2024, at **2:01** p.m., Chairperson Robert Durrah, Jr. presiding.

**Approval of Absentee Ballots**

Deputy Director Michelle Bobadilla presented to the Board a total of 228 absentee ballots for review of which 4 are overseas ballots and 10 ballots for disapproval of at time. 1 ballot with photo ID exception form was reviewed by the Board. Member Draper moved to disapprove the one ballots as the statement to the voters' inability to provide a ID was found false; Secretary Doomy seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

An additional 45 civilian, 2 oversees, and 1 military absentee ballots were presented to the Board for approval.
